Previous uses: here's a list of some of the past uses for the NCRC

Zoomba fitness, board game night, home school support programs, dance classes, summer camps, Lund Flea market, community potlucks, community cafe, ping pong, reunions, cooking classes, community meeting space for all kinds of groups, and more....

Classes include CPR/ first aid/baby saver/AED courses, naloxone training. Hosting parenting classes on guidance and discipline, also sleep management for young children. We had art glass cutting, painting, Ukrainian easter egg classes, and there used to be a sea shanty group that met for sing alongs.
