

The Plan

The qathet Regional District (qRD) has been awarded a \$4.2 million grant to expand the Northside Community Recreation Centre (NCRC) located in Lund/Klah-ah-men.



Additional sq ft: 6,920

New facilities: commercial kitchen, stage/theatre space, half-court gymnasium and storage space, accessible washrooms and a lobby/office. The centre will also serve as the official emergency shelter for this area in the event of a community disaster..

Cost: We'll get a brand new centre for just one third of the true \$6 million cost. The grant covers the majority while \$1.1 million will be borrowed by the qRD (approval pending), resulting in a modest tax increase (est. \$9 per

\$100,000 assessed property value).

Plus, the grant represents some of our federal/provincial tax dollars coming back to us!


